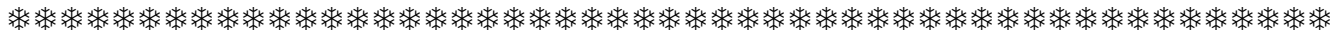

### **Announcing the 2007 Bus Trips**

This is just a heads-up for the bus trips so you'll know the schedule and destinations. Full trip details, ski trail options, costs, and sign-up procedures will be in the October newsletter as always.

#### **Please note:**

- **Four bus trips this year! – a Telluride trip has been added at the beginning of January.**
- **No 2-day trip this year.** All 3-day trips, plus 5 days for Winter Park.
- **No trip on Presidents' Day weekend.**
- **The bus departs from the Lowes parking lot at Paseo del Norte one block east of I-25.** (Same as last couple years.)

#### **Telluride, CO**

January 4-7, 2007 (Thursday-Sunday)

– 2:00pm departure

#### **Silverton, CO**

January 12-15, 2007 (Martin Luther King holiday)

– 5:00pm departure

#### **Leadville, CO**

February 8-11, 2007 (Thursday-Sunday)

– Note: 3-day trip, not two days! Departs Thursday.

– 2:00pm departure

#### **Winter Park, CO**

February 28-March 4, 2007 (Wednesday-Sunday)

– \$430. per person – 9:00am departure

– includes Wednesday dinner and Sunday lunch en route, plus three dinners and four breakfasts at the lodge

### **2007 Hut Trips**

Harry Gates Hut: Thurs Feb 1-Tues Feb 6 (maybe get home Mon Feb 5). Drive up 1<sup>st</sup>, ski in 2<sup>nd</sup>, day ski 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, out 5<sup>th</sup>, drive home 5<sup>th</sup> and maybe 6<sup>th</sup>. Only 6 spots left. Cost is \$117 per person, including dinners at the hut. Harry Gates is the lowest elevation of all of the 10th Mountain Huts, but is by no means the easiest to get to. This is an intermediate trip. Trip is likely to fill up at the Club picnic, so better hurry. Requires leader approval; call Guy Miller at 294-7940 before 9:00pm. Another hut is likely later in the season.

### **Yellowstone on Skis 2007**

Trip is full, *but* the waiting list is empty. See writeup in last March newsletter. The trip will be from Monday January 29 (travel to Yellowstone Monday morning) until Sunday February 4 (return to Albuquerque Sunday afternoon). The program includes 3 days of skiing around Mammoth Hot Springs and 2 days around Old Faithful, staying in the lodges at those locations. Ski trips are led by graduate-degreed experts from the Yellowstone Association Institute. Cost is still expected to be about \$1800, all inclusive, although air costs can change that some. This RELEASE OF LIABILITY will be effective whether or not any loss, damage, injury, or death RESULTS FROM THE NEGLIGENCE of the NMCC Ski Club. I understand that negligence means a failure to do an act which a reasonably careful person would do, or the doing of an act which a reasonably careful person would not do, under the same or similar circumstances, to protect himself, herself, or others from injury or death. I expressly assume the risk of loss, injury, or death suffered by me as a result of participating in any activity. I am voluntarily participating in the activity. I am solely responsible for my own equipment, safety, first aid needs, and medical needs. I will take every precaution to provide for my own safety and well-being while participating in any activity.
